# Web Of Science ResearcherID User Manual

## What is it?

*It is a unique code allowing researchers to create an online profile to display their publication history.*

It is a life-long academical identification number that lets writers gather all their publications in a single place independently of surname changes, different name formats used in publications (e.g. Tanpınar, A. Hamdi ; Tanpınar, Ahmet Hamdi vb.) or organizational shifts.

# Web Of Science ResearcherID User Manual

## **Why is it necessary?**

*It increases the possibility for researchers to be found, and their work to be accessed.*

It provides a secure network gateway enabling colleagues working in common fields to find each other's work quickly and define another researcher as a potential collaborator.
